Initial Licensing Visit conducted 10/22/20. The application could not be marked as licensed due to the fact that the provider's comprehensive background check would not port to her record. Therefore, the provider had to re-print. Permission to operate was issued on 10/29/20 once the new satisfactory comprehensive background check was received.

The provider did not have liability insurance and had the required posting. The following was discussed, and copies were emailed to the director: A copy of the Executive Order issued on August 15, 2020, the Covid-19 checklist and the Covid-19 Guidance for Georgia Child Care Facilities document published on August 12, 2020.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is <u>valid for thirty(30) days</u>.
