- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. ## **Finding**

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation that the following hazards are present on the child playground and accessible to the children in care:

- \*\*\* One green gator Little Tikes rocker was missing two handles leaving four holes the size of a quarter, posing a pinching and entrapment hazard.
- \*\*\*One yellow Step 2 gold fish rocker was missing one handle leaving two holes the size of a nickel, posing a pinching and entrapment hazard.
- \*\*\*Six of six base plates was broken on the tiger bouncey, leaving sharp jagged edges, posing a cutting hazard.
- \*\*\*One red rocky worm was missing two tentacles leaving two holes the size of a nickel, posing a pinching and entrapment hazard.
- \*\*\*One yellow, red, and blue push tricycle had a 2 inch by 2 inch hole, posing a pinching and entrapment hazard.

## **POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.
