<ul> <li>Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee</li> </ul>

(O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was further determined based on the consultant's observation that there were thorny bushes and plants there was discarded equipment located under the shaded area on the route to the playground accessible to children.

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.

# Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(d) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around swimming pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that there was a four inch gap located on the left hand side of the play area causing a potential entrapment hazard.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will enclose the outside play area(s) with a four-foot high fence or other Department-approved barrier and inspect regularly to ensure fencing material is safe and any hazards identified are repaired or replaced. The Home will install or repair a fence around swimming pools that makes them inaccessible to children.

Records of completion of such training programs shall be maintained in the Home by the Provider, as required by these rules. It was determined based on the consultant's review that the provider did not complete ten (10) clock hours of training for 2018.
