An in person Complaint Investigation/Initial Licensing Study was conducted on June 8, 2022. Permission to operate was not granted on this date due to the director needing to submit certificate of occupancy. Once certificate of occupancy is obtained, director can email it consultant and PTO can be granted from the desk. Facility does not carry Liability Insurance. The facility has a capacity limitation of 147 due to the playground capacity of 49. Permission to Operate issued on June 13, 2022.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed
