- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





# Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

### **Finding**

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined the following hazards were present and accessible to children in care:

- \* An unlocked cabinet in the second left classroom contained adult scissors and a stapler.
- \* A safety bag which contained first aid supplies labeled, "keep out of reach of children", was located on a low shelf behind curtains in the fourth left classroom and on top of the cubbies in the second right classroom.
- \* A staff member's purse was located on a low shelf behind the curtains in the fourth left classroom.
- \* A broom and dust pan were located behind a curtain in the third right classroom.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

## **Technical Assistance**

Please ensure that the center and surrounding premises be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Consultant discussed with the director to ensure all vents in the children's bathrooms were securely attached to the ceiling, in working order and free of dust as required. Consultant also discussed with the director to ensure the toilet in the fourth left classroom is repaired properly to ensure continued compliance.

# 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

## **Finding**

591-1-Ī-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined that fencing surrounding Playgrounds A, B, and C measured three feet and three and a half feet in height instead of four feet in height which was required. Additionally, the fences were rusted in some areas and had grass and tree limbs protruding throughout the back fence on Playground B. There was a five inch gap at the bottom of the fence located on Playground A which posed as an entrapment hazard. The fence gate on Playground A was also unlocked on this date.

# **POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
