- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





#### Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

- 3) Select the specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, add the reason for disagreement regarding the rule citation, and upload supporting documentation
- 4) Submit the refutation in DECAL KOALA to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Please ensure the outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. Consultant discussed with the director to ensure the stairway connected to the burgundy, tan, and green multicolored climbing structure on the back right playground is in good repair as the rubber connected to the steps began to peel which could cause a tripping hazard. Consultant also discussed with the director to remove the broken swing on the back left playground.

#### **Technical Assistance**

Please ensure maintenance of resilient surface on all playground areas. Please, add, fluff and redistribute. Playgrounds requires that climbing and swinging equipment have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment and must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency.

#### **Technical Assistance**

Please ensure the playgrounds are kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. Consultant discussed with the director to ensure the fence on the back left playground is free of tree limbs and vegetation protruding through the fence. Additionally, please ensure all fencing is in good repair as the top of the fencing material was separated along the top with rust spots present. Consultant also discussed with the director a plan to ensure the ground is level on the back right playground due to rain.
