If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the large climber on the smaller playground was not in good repair. At the bottom of the large blue tunnel slide, there was a portion of the bottom of the slide that had broken off and was cracked. This left a sharp edge that posed a risk when children came down the slide.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the program did not have evidence of conducting and documenting drills for fire, tornado and other emergency situations, as required. Based on a review of emergency drill documentation, the program did not have evidence that a fire drill was conducted in February or March 2023.

The Center will hold the drills as required and keep the documentation of the drills on file for two years.
