An in person Monitoring Visit was completed on this day. The provider stated there are 8 staff members with 1 being a new hire since the consultant's last visit. The provider stated no medication is administered, no field trip or routine transportation is provided. Supporting documents for the administrative review are to be uploaded by close of business on Wednesday, August 3, 2022. Documents were uploaded during the visit and the AR was completed.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





### Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

It was determined based on review of child # 1 file that the allergic to section is missing.
