- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding

591-1-1-.08(1) requires the Center Staff to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled. In order for the file to be complete, the file shall contain the following: child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone numbers, relationship to child and to Parent(s), and other identifying information; name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, intellectual disabilities or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on review of child files that one of five files were missing the allergy information.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will develop a plan that includes how to obtain all required information for currently enrolled children and how to ensure this is done for future enrollees as well. The plan will also include how and where to maintain files for the required amount of time. The plan will be implemented and followed.

Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on observation that the large oval area A, B, and C rug located in classroom 202 is soiled and accessible to the three-year-old children. Additionally, the left bathroom located in classroom K, three and four-year-old, classroom, is missing the light fixture cover and in need of repair.

It was determined based on review of the transportation checklist for the vehicle with tag number RDQ13374, that on Wednesday, March 1, 2023, no children were checked as loading the van at Center Elementary School located at 2114 Dorothy St. Waycross, Ga. and no children were checked as unloading the van at Second Baptist Church located at 301 Tomberlin Road, Waycross, Georgia during the PM route.
