If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. # 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

#### Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the following hazards were present:

Right Playground:

- ---The red caboose tunnel is chipping paint.
- ---The yellow caboose tunnel is chipping paint.
- ---The red metal fire truck is chipping paint and the stickers are peeling from the wheels.

Back Playground:

- ---The merry-go-round is turned upside down where the metal frame is accessible to the children.
- ---The purple metal car is chipping paint and the stickers are peeling from the wheels.
- ---The large blue metal train engine is chipping paint.
- ---The red metal slide is chipping paint.

# Front Playground:

- --- The yellow stair cases are chipping paint.
- ---The blue metal frame and stair cases are chipping paint.
- ---The top of the red metal train is rusting and chipping paint.

It was determined based on observation that an infant was sleeping in an infant swing for approximately ten minutes without being transferred to a crib as required.
