Comments

An in person Licensing Study was conducted on this day. The center director stated mediation is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided. The center is reconstructing their playgrounds and have divided one playground into two and have added an additional playground for a total of four playgrounds. Additionally, the center has added a modular unit which is being used for children receiving services (PT, OT, Speech, etc.). The center director will request an amendment for the playgrounds and the modular unit to be licensed no later than Monday, November 21, 2022 and will not use these areas until they are licensed.

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).



Please refer to the website, http://www.decal.ga.gov/CCS/RulesAndRegulations.aspx , for information regarding October 1, 2018 rule changes about Criminal Records Checks that may affect your facility. In summary,

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

Refutation Process:

You have the right to refute any of the citations noted in this report with which you disagree. To refute a citation(s), do the following:

- 1) Log into DECAL KOALA www.decalkoala.com with the userid for your program
- 2) On the home page scroll down to the Inspection Reports and select 'Refute Citation' for the visit report in dispute
- 3) Select the specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, add the reason for disagreement regarding the rule citation, and upload supporting documentation
- 4) Submit the refutation in DECAL KOALA to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.25(19) prohibits the use of unapproved areas for children's activity. It was determined based on observation and the center director's statement that the center has reconstructed their playground area and divided one playground into two and added another playground for a total of four playgrounds. The playground divided into two is being used by the Head Start Children. Additionally, a modular unit has been added to the property and is being used to provide Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and Speech Therapy to the children. An amendment request has not been submitted to the department for re measurements and licensing for three of the four playgrounds or the modular unit.

The center director will submit an amendment request to re measure, add three playgrounds and the modular unit and license each no later than Monday, November 21, 2022. The center director will ensure that the two new playground areas and the modular unit will not be used until licensed.
