An in person POI Follow - Up was completed on this day. Five children were present with the provider on this day. Ms. Robinson said that her window air condition unit had quit over the weekend and she has called her repair man to come fix it. The consultant discussed with Ms. Robinson to be mindful of the heat index and to utilize open windows and ceiling fans for air flow through the home. Additionally, it was discussed that the provider could purchase fans to place through out the home and to place them up and out of reach of the children with no dangling cords.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





# Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.
