- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

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Findings Report

591-1-1-.15 Food Service & Nutrition

Finding

591-1-1-.15(10) requires that portions of food or drink which are served to children or placed on the table for service and are not consumed at that meal or snack by the children to whom the portions are served shall be thrown away. Any formula or breast milk remaining one hour from the beginning of the feeding shall be discarded or returned to Parent(s). It was determined based on an investigation that on January 21, 2022, staff statements revealed that a five-month-old child was fed at approximately 11:00 a.m. and that the remaining formula was discarded. It was further revealed that staff statements revealed that a five-month-old child was fed at approximately 2:35 p.m. by a staff member. Staff statements even further revealed that the staff were aware that a five-month-old child's remaining formula was not discarded one hour from the beginning of the feeding at 2:35 p.m., and that the remaining formula was fed to the child at 4:55 p.m.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor that food, drink, formula, and breast milk are discarded or returned to Parent(s) as required.
