<u>Comments</u> Background checks were all reviewed on September 9, 2021. A virtual inspection was conducted on September 9, 2021 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Consultant observed 39 children and 3 staff on the playgrounds, 23 children and 1 staff in the gym (special use).

 - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee
