 - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

290-2-3-.13 Playgrounds(CR)

Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based off observation that multiple holes in the ground were observed throughout the play area that caused tripping hazards to children in care.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.

Correction Deadline: 6/16/2022

Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(c) requires that climbing and swinging equipment that are not portable have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment, which is adequately maintained by the Home to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based off observation that the rope climber and the swings only measured 2 inches of resilient surfacing beneath the fall zone areas. It was determined based off observation that the slide only measure 1 inches of resilient surfacing beneath the fall zone area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will ensure that there is an adequate resilient surface under and in the fall zone of climbing and swinging equipment. The Home will inspect equipment and resilient surfacing material regularly and repair or replenish as needed.

Correction Deadline: 6/16/2022

Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(d) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined based off observation on the far back right side of the playground there were three large openings located on the top fence bar and was observed detached. It was determined based off measurements on today's visit there were three 9ft 5 in gaps on the top bar fencing.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will enclose the outside play area(s) with a four-foot high fence or other Department-approved barrier and inspect regularly to ensure fencing material is safe and any hazards identified are repaired or replaced. The Home will install or repair a fence around swimming pools that makes them inaccessible to children.
