Comments

The purpose for today's visit was to conduct a licensing study and a Category 3 complaint investigatio for intake 44323. All questions were answered during the visit and technical assistance was provided. An exit conference was conducted with the staff person in charge and a copy of the report was provided to the center.

Consultant discussed that all provisional and substitute staff must have an employee file that includes orientation. Provisional staff that become perminent must have annual training. Substitute staff providing routine supervision must be supervised by a lead staff with the approved training and background checks on file.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed 01/01/0001

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

During a monitoring visit, children were observed to be served snacks that were placed on the table with not plates, bowls or serving equipment.

Finding

591-1-1-.10(4) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on observation that the changing surface in Room C Toddlers 3rd L was not in good repair as required. During a monitoring visit, the blue changing pad was observed to have a tear and slit in the porous top. The pad was observed to not be in good repair.

The Center will ensure that the nonporous surface is in good repair at all times.
