**Comments**

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a complaint investigation and follow up to the monitoring visit completed on January 15, 2021. The consultant answered all of the center staff's questions and provided guidance in areas needed. Center administrators were provided a copy of this report at the conclusion of the exit conference.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee



### Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

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### Findings Report

**Finding**

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on consultant's observation of the playground area that there was less than one to two inches of resilient surface surrounding the fall zones of the playground structure on the back playground. In addition, there was less than two inches of resilient surface surrounding bar swing on the right side of the playground structure.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.
