- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. 591-1-103(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engaging activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on an investigation that center staff failed to refrain from engaging in activities detrimental to a child's health or we being when a center staff picked up a child by the waist, carried the child to the front desk location, where child was dropped on the ground. Professional medical attention was sought as a precaution. the involved person was terminated as a result of the incident.	ough rell- the
