- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation that the porch area to the playground and entrance to the home had exposed concrete. Also the gutters on the house needed covering.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.

**Technical Assistance**

The consultant advised the provider to repair the white fence behind the basketball goal that was off track and need to be leveled. Also she will need to add lattice to the white fence in the front where the city wouldn't allow her to have the fence at the required height.

The provider submitted that notarized letter and it is included in the documents.
