- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance

Finding

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observations that in classroom E the storage closet was unlocked leaving cleaning tools and a teacher's bag accessible to children, in classroom H the storage closet was unlocked with cleaning tools accessible and in classroom D, the storage under the diaper table was unlocked with diaper cream accessible. It was further determined that a toilet brush and plunger were accessible in the hall bathroom for the after school children.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

Comment

Discussed maintenance of resilient surface. Please fluff and redistribute.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observations that the small red, yellow, green and blue slide is missing covers for three of the four support posts leaving a rusted metal disk exposed. It was further determined that two white doors to the building on the left side of the playground had chipping paint and rust exposed and two swings had chains with cracked and peeling plastic coverings.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will replace the post coverings for the slid or remove the equipment from the playground. Swing chains should be replaced and the door will be repaired to eliminate the rust and chipping paint. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Health and Hygiene**591-1-1-.10 Diapering Areas & Practices(CR)****Not Met****Comment**

Staff state proper knowledge of diapering procedures.

Finding

591-1-1-.10(1) requires Centers first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that are renovated after March 1, 1991, to provide ventilation in the diapering areas with functioning exhaust fans and a duct system or by the required amount of window space provided by operable windows when open. It was determined based on observation that the ventilation fan in classroom G was not operational.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The responsible person(s) at the center will ensure that the exhaust fans and duct systems are functioning or that the required amount of operable window space is provided in each diapering area.
