- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is **valid for thirty(30) days**. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. The Consultant discussed adding equipment and toys to enhance variety.

Finding

591-1-1-.12(2) requires that all equipment and furniture be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint; and be kept clean. It was determined based on observation that the tables in all classrooms had chipped paint and the chairs had rusted bottoms and the shelving in each room needed had chipped paint as well. The cribs in the infant room had chipped paint and no known manufacturing dates.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will be sure to replace all the equipment to ensure it is free from hazards and satisfy Bright from the Start requirements..

Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on observation that the bathrooms in the non-diapering classrooms were missing the screws on the base of the toilets.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will replace the toilet screws on all toilets.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the fence on the afterschool playground starting from left to right panels three to six were leaning and on the infant toddler playground panel three to five were leaning. The bottom of the fence is separated from the pole on panel six and panel ten and 11.

Correction Deadline: 11/6/2025

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the afterschool and infant toddler playground had large spider webs under the green slide on both of the playgrounds as well as the entrance from the back of the playground to the afterschool playground. The concrete connection between the concrete and pour in play is not level and needs repair.

Infant /Toddler:

Blue three wheel toy had chipped paint

Red car with yellow wheels had chipped paint

Green sliding board was faded

Silver tunnel was rusted

Afterschool:

Wooden bench was broken on one side

Green slides were faded

Balls were deflated and red and yellow football was missing pieces of fabric

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
