- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

It was determined that one of six staff members did not complete the criminal records check prior to working with the children in the program as required.

The Program will ensure the criminal records check is completed as required. The a follow up of the review of the criminal records check will be completed on the follow up visit.

EX-HS-.W First Aid & CPR (NCP)**Not Met****Finding**

EX-HS-.W(1) requires Program Staff to successfully complete a biennial training program in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and a triennial training program in first aid. The first aid training must be done by certified or licensed health care professionals or trainers and must deal with the provision of emergency care to infants and children. The Program shall maintain current evidence of the successful completion of such training which shall be available to the Department for inspection. It was determined that four of six staff members did not complete CPR and First Aid training as required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Program will ensure that CPR and First Aid training is completed and kept on file. A review of staff training, including CPR and First Aid training is reviewed on the follow up visit.

EX-HS-.P Staff Training (NCP)**Not Met****Finding**

EX-HS-.P(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined that four of six staff members did complete the Health and Safety training as required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Program will ensure health and safety training is completed as required and kept on file. The staff training files will be reviewed on the follow up visit.
