- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. - 2) On the home page scroll down to the Inspection Reports and select 'Refute Citation' for the visit report in dispute

- 4) Submit the refutation in DECAL KOALA to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

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Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)



#### Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

Finding

It was determined based upon observation that there were two prescribed single use insulin syringes in a child's back pack hanging in the cubby area accessible to children. The Provider stated that they do not administer the medication.

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the Home Provider will make these items inaccessible to the children.

**Finding**

290-2-3-.11(1)(d) prohibits Personnel from dispensing prescription or nonprescription medications to a Child without specific written authorization from the Child's physician or Parent. All medications shall be stored as authorized by Georgia law or in accordance with the prescription or label instructions and kept in places that are inaccessible to children. Each dose of medication given to a Child shall be documented showing the Child's name, name of medication, date and time given, and the name of the person giving the medication. It was determined based upon observation that two prescription bottles of hydrocortisone were stored in a child's back pack hanging in the cubby area accessible to children. It was further determined that the Provider did not have a written authorization from the Child's physician or Parent. The Provider stated that they do not administer the medication.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Home will store medicine as required in an area that is locked or not accessible to children.

Unconfined pets shall not be permitted in child care areas when any Child is present except for supervised learning experiences. It was determined based upon a review of records that the Provider had a pet with a vaccination record that had expired on February 25, 2024.

The Home will ensure that all animals are properly vaccinated and that unconfined animals are not allowed in child care areas.
