- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

# **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.03(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on staff interviews and statements that the allegation of on December 21, 2022, a staff member pulled a three-year-old child's arm to keep the child from running into an unknown area of the facility resulting in a Nursemaid's Elbow injury is substantiated. Staff statements and interviews revealed that on December 21, 2022, staff in the three-year-old classroom attempted to stop a three-year-old child in care from running around the three-year-old classroom by grabbing their arm. Staff statements further revealed that upon grabbing the three-year-old child's arm, the child began to cry and after staff attempted to remove the child's jacket, they began to cry more intensely. Administrative staff applied ice to the effected arm because of the child favoring it until the child was picked up by the parent. Due to the preponderance of evidence from staff statements and interviews, this allegation is substantiated.
