It was determined based on observation that in classroom AS Wing- Youth Room, a television was in the classroom on a cart and was not secured to the cart to prevent tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. Additionally, there were two stacks of chairs with five chairs in each stack in classroom AS Wing- 1st Right that could potentially be pushed or pulled over.

It was determined based on observation that classroom AS Wing- 1st Right, that house 8 one-year-old children and 11 two-year-old children, was using a temporary classroom that did not have a diaper changing surface that was smooth, nonporous, and equipped with guard rails as required. Additionally, staff stated that diaper changes were being completed on a counter without a guard rail or on a mat that was not nonporous.

The Center will ensure there is a smooth, nonporous changing surface that has a guard or rails for safety in each classroom that houses children wearing diapers. Center Staff will be trained and have adequate supplies to properly clean the diaper changing surface between each diaper change.

Finding

591-1-1-.17(8) requires staff to wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for the day, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after diapering each child, dispensing medication, applying topical medications, handling and preparing food, eating, drinking, preparing bottles, feeding each child, assisting children with eating and drinking, after toileting or assisting children with toileting, using tobacco products, handling garbage and organic waste, touching animals or pets, handling bodily fluids and after contamination by any means. It was determined based on observation that in classrooms AS Wing- 1st Right and AS Wing- Youth Room there was no liquid hand soap present for handwashing as required. Additionally, center staff stated that they were using hand sanitizer in place of liquid soap.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure liquid soap and warm running water are available for handwashing, train Staff on the handwashing requirements, review the requirements with Staff periodically, and monitor handwashing.
