 - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the following playground haards were observed:

-On the middle swing post there was a large area of chipped paints and pieces of chipped paint on the ground near the swings accessible to the children.

-At the bottom of the exit doors leading out from classrooms A and B, there was rusted and jagged metal where the window meets the glass. Additionally, on the windows beside the doors, there was rusted and jagged metal accessible to the children posing a potential hazard.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.
