For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the following items on the playground were in need of repair:

-The two person swing on the brown Step 2 playground equipment was missing a bolt and was not secured posing a potential hazard.

-The pink and purple ride on toy was missing the seat and was in need of repair.

-The steering wheel in the middle of the yellow sit and spin toy was rusted and had sharp edges and posed a potential hazard.
