<u>Comments</u>
The purpose of today's visit is to conduct a Monitoring Visit. The center provides routine transportation and the vehicle and logs were reviewed on this date. All staff Criminal Background Check Records were reviewed on this date.

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).



Please refer to the website, http://www.decal.ga.gov/CCS/RulesAndRegulations.aspx, for information regarding October 1, 2018 rule changes about Criminal Records Checks that may affect your facility. In summary,

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





# **Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:**

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

The driver or other designated staff person shall document in writing with a different mark/symbol to account for each child listed on the passenger transportation checklist who was not present on the vehicle for any reason. An explanation shall be documented in writing whenever a child is transported to a field trip site but is not present on the return trip to the Center. It was determined based on a review of records that on October 28, 2022, one out of six children was not documented with a mark or symbol to account for being loaded and unloaded from the vehicle on the route from Juliette Low Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.

# **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The driver/other designated person will immediately document in writing with a check/mark/symbol each time a child gets on and off the vehicle.

# **Finding**

591-1-1-.36(7)(d)1. requires that the first check be conducted immediately upon unloading the last child at any location including, but not limited to, a field trip destination, arrival at the Center, and the last stop during transportation to home or school. The responsible person on the vehicle shall physically walk through the entire vehicle; visually inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats and in all compartments or recesses in the vehicle's interior; sign the passenger transportation checklist (s), indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle; and give the passenger transportation checklist(s) to the second designated Staff person. It was determined based on a review of records that a first check was not documented as completed on the following routes:

- -On October 28, 2022, a first check was not documented as completed on the afternoon route from Heard Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.
- -On October 28, 2022, a first check was not documented as completed on the afternoon route from Juliette Low Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.
- -On November 4, 2022, a first check was not documented as completed on the morning route from Juliette Low Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.

There shall be continuous watchful oversight of the vehicle between the first check and second check. It was determined based on a review of records that a second check was not documented as completed on the following routes:

- -On October 28, 2022, a second check was not documented as completed on the afternoon route from Heard Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.
- -On October 28, 2022, a second check was not documented as completed on the afternoon route from Juliette Low Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.
- -On November 4, 2022, a second check was not documented as completed on the morning route from Juliette Low Elementary School to El Shaddai Academy.
