- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

## **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.03(2) requires the Center to keep current lesson plans on site that reflect appropriate instruction practices and activities to support children's development The Center shall have sufficient and varied play and learning equipment and materials to support the above program of activities in all developmental areas. It was determined based on findings which included statements, interviews, and documentation, this allegation was substantiated. The week from February 27, 2023, up until April 10, 2023, the three-year-old classroom did not have lesson plans available upon request. The staff statements revealed that the lesson plans were not being done due to short staffing. There was no evidence of the lesson plans being completed from March 6th through April 10th of 2023.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will keep current lesson plans on site that include appropriate instruction practices and activities and will have sufficient and varied play and learning equipment and materials to support the activities.

# **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.15(9) requires that a written statement be on file from a medical authority when a child requires a modified diet for medical reasons and from the child's Parent(s) when a child requires a modified diet for religious reasons. All caregiver Personnel shall be informed of the diet restriction for the child and only food that complies with the prescribed dietary regimen but still meets the food and nutrition requirements shall be served to the child. It was determined based on findings which included statements, interviews, and documentation, this allegation was substantiated. On April 5, 2023, center staff failed to modify the diet of a three-year-old child with a dairy allergy, when the child was served goldfish crackers. Staff statements revealed that the child was given goldfish crackers during snack time. The allergy form revealed that the child has a dairy allergy.

The Center will obtain the appropriate written statement and keep it on file, inform all caregiver Staff, and only serve the child food that complies, but still meets the nutrition requirements in these rules and will review and monitor.
