- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

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Activities and Equipment
91-1-103 Activities Not Med
Finding (91-1-103(3)) requires the Center to offer opportunities for each child to make choices in a variety of activities. It was determined based on an investigation that on July 26, 2021, that although there were a variety of toys available in the classroom, the children were not allowed to access them.
Correction Deadline: 8/6/2021
Finding 191-1-103(8) requires a center to provide individual attention to each child by responding promptly to the hild's distress signals and need for comfort. It was determined based on an investigation that on July 26, 2021 individual attention was not provided to a one-year-old child as required after an altercation between two one-ear-old children. The one-year-old child obtained multiple scratch marks and a human bite as a result of the altercation. Center staff did not offer comfort to the child, but instead kept them at arm's length while examining their injuries and later placed the child alone at a table.

Correction Deadline: 8/6/2021
Finding 591-1-103(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on an investigation that on July 26, 2021, a staff member picked up a one-year-old child in a manner that could cause injury when the staff grabbed the child by the arm and lifted the child approximately two feet in the air and moved to another location in the classroom.
Correction Deadline: 8/6/2021
Finding 591-1-103(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on an investigation that on July 26, 2021, staff did not intervene when two children were involved in an altercation in the classroom. The staff member did not redirect the children to prevent the incident from occurring. Further, the staff member stood near the children and watched the altercation and did not intervene. The altercation resulted in a one-year-old sustaining a bite mark and scratches on the face. The child received professional medical treatment for the injuries.
