- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Activities and Equipment

591-1-1-.03 Activities Not Met

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.03(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined that a three-year-old child fell from a playground bridge and sustained a broken left arm. Investigative findings revealed that a three-year-old child fell from the top rope of the double tower Kompan outdoor climbing equipment, which was approximately 3 feet, 9 inches from the ground. Investigative findings further revealed that staff did not redirect the child's choice, but allowed the child to continue in an activity that could be detrimental to the child's health or well-being. As a result, the three-year-old child who stands at 3 feet, 5 inches tall, fell and broke two bones in their left arm.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will review requirements with Staff to ensure that appropriate activities are conducted with children.
