## Comments

An Administrative Review was conducted on February 25, 2022. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. An in-person visit was conducted on February 17, 2022 with the director.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





#### **Important New Deadlines:**

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

1R classroom- Two bottles of Swiffer cleaner were observed on the blue counter accessible to children.

2R-A magic eraser and plastic bags were observed in an unlocked drawer located under the blue counter.

3R-A bottle of Fabulosa cleaner and a container of Clorox wipes were observed in an unlocked cabinet to the right of the sink.

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.
