Finding

591-1-1-.08(2) requires Center Staff to maintain a file for each child that includes evidence of age-appropriate immunizations or a signed affidavit against such immunizations for each child enrolled in the center on a form approved by the Department, and to allow no child to continue enrollment in the Center for more than thirty (30) days without such evidence. It was determined through a review of records from the Carroll County Health Department on September 8, 2021, the center had 70% compliance and on October 8, 2021, the center had 70% compliance.
