The purpose of this visit was to conduct a POI follow up to the previous citation from March 24, 2021. A virtual inspection was conducted on May 12, 2021 with the provider. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive order issued on May 1, 2021 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee
