

An Administrative Review was conducted on October 27, 2021. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on October 29, 2021 with the director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

591-1-1-.36(7)(c) 3. requires that the driver or other designated person document in writing the time of arrival and departure each time the vehicle departs from the Center, is loaded or unloaded at each school and when the vehicle returns to the Center; each time the vehicle departs from the Center, arrives at the location where any child is picked up or dropped off and when the vehicle returns to the Center; each time the vehicle leaves the Center, arrives at a field trip destination, leaves a field trip destination, and returns to the Center. It was determined based on review of records that the driver did not document in writing the time of arrival of the vehicle during the following times of routine transportation:

October 1, 2021 depart, unload and return time was not noted for afternoon transportation from Ferguson Elementary School and October 1, 2021 return time to facility was not noted for afternoon transportation from Knight Elementary School.

The Center will ensure that each time of arrival and departure is documented by the driver or designated person with training, review and monitoring.

The responsible person on the vehicle shall physically walk through the entire vehicle; visually inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats and in all compartments or recesses in the vehicle's interior; sign the passenger transportation checklist (s), indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle; and give the passenger transportation checklist(s) to the second designated Staff person. It was determined based on review of documents that a there was not a first check signature indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle for the following routes:

October 4, 2021 return to the facility in the morning transportation from Ferguson Elementary. September 30, 2021 return to the facility for the afternoon transportation from Bethesda Elementary and on October 1, 2021 return to the facility for the afternoon transportation from Ferguson Elementary.
