All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the following items were in need of being repaired and/or cleaned: -three of four infant swing chains were rusted at the top

-black plastic covering was coming off on the sliding equipment steps on the Large playground that had exposed rust

-the red metal equipment on the Large Playground was chipping paint and had exposed rust -yellow slides and picnic tables were in need of being cleaned due to a black reside

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that three active ant beds were observed on the Large playground around the swings. It was further determined the Large playground had several pine cones throughout.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
