An Administrative Review was conducted on September 30, 2021. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on September 30, 2021 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

On this date consultant discussed rule changes effective October 1, 2020.

Consultant requested to review all Criminal Record checks for all employees hired after last visit. Director provided nine files for employees hired since last visit.

Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.
