It was determined based on observation that hand sanitizer that stated "keep out of reach of children" was observed to be sitting on a table in classroom 111. It was further determined that disinfectant spray was observed to be sitting in the unlocked diaper cabinet in classroom 105.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

It was determined based on observation that there was a four inch gap between the wooden closure and fence which was due to the rotten wood dislodging from the original structure which posed an entrapment hazard for children.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times appropriate to the individual age, needs and capabilities of each child. Such supervision must include, but not be limited to, indoor and outdoor activities, mealtimes, naptime, transportation, field trips, and transitions between activities. "Supervision" means that the appropriate number of Staff members are physically present in the area where children are being cared for and are providing watchful oversight to the children, volunteers and Students-in-Training. The persons supervising in the child care area must be alert, positioned to maximize their ability to hear and see the children at all times, and able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the volunteers and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. Staff shall be attentive and participating with all children during mealtimes and shall be seated within an arm's length away from children thirty-six (36) months of age and younger. It was determined based on observation that two children were observed to walk out of classroom 111 and go to the restroom across the hall without adult supervision.

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
