 - Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
 - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

It was determined based upon observation that a four and one half inch gap was present at the back right side of the fence on the playground causing a potential entrapment hazard. It was also determined that a four in gap from the ground to the fence was present on the right side of the fence on the far back of the playground causing a potential entrapment hazard.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
