 - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on observation that the white changing pad in the one and two-year-old clasroom was torn in multiple spots.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure there is a smooth, nonporous changing surface that has a guard or rails for safety in each classroom that houses children wearing diapers. Center Staff will be trained and have adequate supplies to properly clean the diaper changing surface between each diaper change.
