

- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

An explanation shall be documented in writing whenever a child is transported to a field trip site but is not present on the return trip to the Center. It was determined, based on review of records, that the driver or other designated person failed to document the following:

- •One of 13 children was lacking the mark/symbol for loading and unloading the vehicle from the Center to McDonald's and from McDonald's to the Center during a field trip on July 20, 2022.
- •Two of 13 children were lacking the mark/symbol for unloading the vehicle at the Center at the conclusion of the field trip on June 9, 2022, to Brookfield Park.
- •Three of four children were lacking the mark/symbol for loading and unloading the vehicle used for routine transportation from Steven's Creek Elementary to the Center on December 2, 2022.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The driver/other designated person will immediately document in writing with a check/mark/symbol each time a child gets on and off the vehicle.

It was determined, based on review of records, that the arrival and departure times were not documented for transportation to and from Brookfield Park on June 9, 2022, for Bus #2.

It was determined, based on review of records, that Staff #2 hired on October 4, 2022, and Staff #18 hired on October 3, 2022, were identified as teacher assistants did not have evidence of submitting both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site as required before beginning employment at the Center.
