The Director stated that trainings in appropriate handling of children has been scheduled for all staff and staff were reminded of rules and regulations regarding picking up and handling children.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.03(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on investigation, that on February 23, 2021, at approximately 1:50 p.m., a staff member picked up a one-year-old child in a manner that caused an injury to the child's left arm, while in the classroom. The injury resulted in professional medical attention.
