  - Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
  - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





#### Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the following hazards were present:

The back play area had the front middle red landscaping timber was broken with rough edges and an exposed nail.

The front play area 3 exposed nail heads on the back post where the swings had been located. The front play area had a green fabric covering over the wooden play structure that was torn.

## **POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.
