It was determined based on observation and measurement that the following structures required more resilient surfacing:

Back left playground:

The red, blue and yellow climbing structure that measured over 5' in height had 1" when 6" was required. The swings had 1" when 6" was required.

Back right playground:

The red, blue and yellow climbing structure that measured under 5' in height had 1/2" when 3" was required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.
