It was determined based on a review of records that the center did not obtain specific written authorization from the child's parent to include the date, full name of the child, name of the medication, prescription number, dosage, the dates to be given, the time of day to be dispensed and signature of the parent in order to dispense emergency medications (Benadryl and Epinephrine) for a child who required an allergy action plan.
