- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





#### Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

**Finding** 

591-1-1-26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that there were exposed roots on the far side of the large piece of playground equipment on the Back Right Playground and a tripping hazard was posed. Further, there was newly poured concrete with sharp edges. Also, on the Left Playground there was exposed concrete along the pavilion and the sidewalk adjacent to the concrete along the pavilion with a five inch drop off from the sidewalk to the ground.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards. The roots will be painted with a bright spray paint to make them visible to children and staff. A rubberized surface or outdoor carpet will be placed on the newly poured concrete, or other repair deemed by the Maintenance Manager. The five inch drop off will be corrected and exposed concrete covered.
