- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on investigative findings that the center had damage to the ceilings and walls in classroom D-R Hall L, E-4R, and F-3R, when children were present for care.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.25(5) requires approval from the Department, local zoning authorities, fire safety agencies and local building authorities for any structural changes to an existing Center or for construction of a new Center. Construction and maintenance work shall take place only in areas that are not accessible to the children. It was determined based on investigative findings that on January 18, 2023, construction work was taking place in classrooms D-R Hall L, E-4R, and F-3R, and in hallways accessible to children in care.

The Center will secure the required approvals and plan all construction and maintenance work so it is inaccessible to children.
