- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.25(14) requires the Center to be lighted with a minimum of twenty-five foot candles of illumination except during rest periods. Areas used for napping shall be lit dimly. Not all rooms were appropriately illuminated when staff stated the lamp used in that classroom had broken a couple of weeks prior and the children did not sleep well without the curtain being closed. In regards to the allegation that on June 28, 2022, the two-year-old classroom had poor lighting. It was reported the classroom was so dark it was difficult to see children's faces. It was determined based on staff statement and interviews, this allegation was substantiated.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that appropriate lighting is provided, the center will open the curtain during nap time or use a lamp.
