Comments

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a Licensing Study. This visit was conducted virtually between the Director and Consultant on August 24, 2022.

An Administrative Review was not required due to the Provider being temporarily closed. Director's annual training for 2021 was emailed to the consultant.

An Exit conference was conducted with the Director of August 24, 2022 to discuss the Licensing Study report.

Consultant discussed with the Provider the requirements to keep her license while remaining temporarily closed:

10 Hours of ongoing annual training each year

CPR and First Aid remain current

Criminal Records Check remain current for all living in the home.

Pay yearly license fee

Two visits by the consultant will still be conducted each year

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee



Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance.
