An Administrative Review of requested documents for a Monitoring Visit was completed on April 20, 2022 by the Consultant.

An Exit Conference was held with the Director on April 21, 2022 by the Consultant discussing the Monitoring report. Consultant emailed a copy of the Monitoring report to the Director requesting signature and to be returned to the Consullant within two business days.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

It was determined based on review of Authorization of Medication forms for RM there was no record of medication being dispensed to the child on the following dates: March 4, March 8, March 15, March 25, March 31, April 1, April 4, April 5, April 6, April 7, April 8, April 15 and April 18, 2022. In addition, the Authorization of Medication forms for NB, there was no record of medication being dispensed to the child on the following dates: March 17, March 21 and March 22, 2022. Also for NB, the time medication was dispensed to the child is missing.
